- Jay Hines brought John Courtright from Washington. He informed the group that he had known Jay for 62 years. Is that possible?

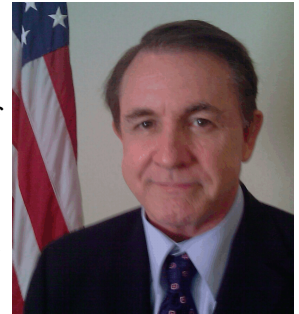
